
Year 3 Spring 2025





## Geography

In Geography, children will be learning about Mount Vesuvius. Students will be looking at earthquakes, tectonic plates and how and why volcanoes erupt.

## Science

Across the Spring Term, we will have two different scientific topics to investigate. Rocks and Soils, where children will look at how rocks are formed, observe different types of soil and explore fossils. In Forces and Magnets, we will explore movement and friction, magnetic attraction and investigate the theory of polarisation.









Within Religious Education we will develop children's knowledge and understanding of Hinduism.

We will then move on to Salvation, looking at why Christians call the day Jesus died Good Friday.

In Year 3 we will be reading and exploring Paddington, Cinderella of the Nile, Flotsam, Diary of a Killer Cat and Charlotte's Web. Year 3 children will learn to write for a range of different purposes and audiences.

# History

In History we will be exploring what life was like for the Ancient Egyptians. Looking at social hierarchy, mummification and hieroglyphics. We will be observing artefacts and completing research to support our learning.



Children will build on their knowledge and understanding of Computing. This is will include a touch typing scheme of work and email safety including, composing emails and communication. We use Purple Mash in school and children have their own logins to access from home.

## Mathematics

During our Mathematics lessons we are going to build on our calculation skills, learning different written methods. We will explore in greater depth, place value, money, shape, fractions, measures, data handling and reading and telling the time. Children will continually apply their knowledge to a range of problems and solve reasoning style questions with increasing depth.

# Wellbeing

In Wellbeing this term we are focusing on our Dreams and Goals. We will also gain a deeper understanding of families, relationships and children's rights.



For our Art topic, we will be getting our inspiration from Pierre Mondrian and Giuseppe Arcimboldo and exploring a range of drawing techniques. In DT we will be designing shell structures using computer aided design.
